

Flair/Producers Group Records Discography

The Producers Group was a production company headed by concert manager and record producer Norman Schwartz. The record label listed the label's location as New York and Los Angeles. Schwartz had previously started the Skye and Gryphon labels, and was a well-known producer whose recordings netted six grammy awards. Schwartz started the new Flair/PG label as a vehicle for his live concert recordings; both of the albums below were produced by Schwartz.
